James R. "Jim" Flynn, 83, passed away in his home on June 12, 2022. He was born on January 13, 1939 in Hendersonville, NC to Harry and Evelyn Flynn. Jim graduated from Anthony Wayne High School, class of 1957 and attended Ohio and Toledo University. He played on the Atlanta Braves Baseball team, as a pitcher, from 1960-1967. Jim was the chairman and owner of Corporate Constructors, a recruiting firm for Architecture and Construction. Jim served on Walbridge Park Board, and was a trustee for the Boilermaker union, local 85. He was inducted to the Anthony Wayne High School alumni sports hall of fame in 2008. Jim will be remembered as an outgoing, warm and friendly neighbor and friend, and the best Papa in the world.

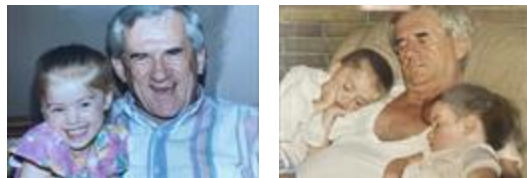

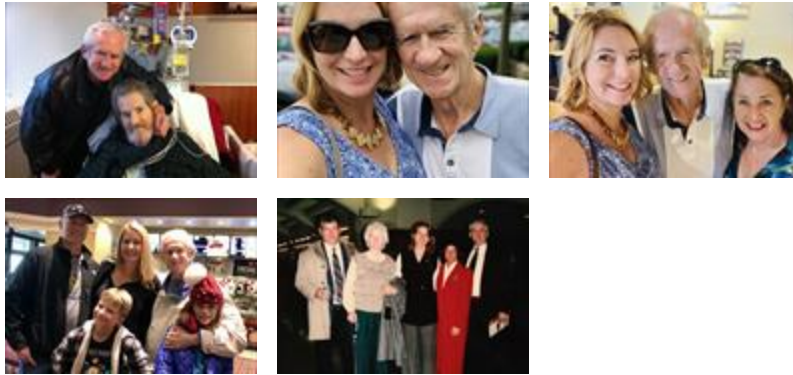
