James P. Limongi, 74 years of Toledo Ohio passed away on Saturday May 14, 2016 in the University of Toledo Medical Center surrounded by his loving family. Jim was born in Toledo Ohio on July 9, 1941 to James V. and Josephine Limongi. He was a graduate of Libbey High School and served in the United States Air Force.

Jim was a painter by trade and worked for a short time for the Jeep Chrysler Corp. Jim was self-employed as a painter, had worked for the University of Toledo Medical Center and retired from the City of Toledo after 27 years of service.

In his retirement years Jim enjoyed painting works of art, cooking Italian food for his family, and getting together with old lifelong friends and cousins. He was the most kind, gentle man, who could talk to anyone. He was especially known for his humorous storytelling, which would leave you in stitches for hours. Most of all, he enjoyed spending his time with his nephew whom he considered to be his grandson “his little Peeps”, Blake Foster.

Jim was preceded in death by his parents and father-in-law Carl Barrick. He is survived by his loving wife of 41 years, Rose Mary Limongi, his loving children Nick, Gina and Joey Limongi; mother in-law Fay Barrick; sisters Catherine Gasser and Jean Meyers; brother Paul Limongi; brother-in-law’s Joseph, Bill
