James R. McIntire, 91 years of Maumee Ohio passed away Wednesday May 5, 2010 in his home surrounded by his loving family.

James was born in Toledo Ohio to James P. and Lena McIntire. He attended Clay High School and served in the United States Army from 1941 to 1945 during WWII in the South Pacific. James started in the hair styling business in the Antoine Room at the former LaSalle's Department Store downtown Toledo. He owned and operated five beauty salons in various locations around Toledo and 1 in Perrysburg Ohio. After he retired, James worked for the Meijer's Store in Maumee Ohio as a greeter and then for the Elite Marketing Company inside the Meijer's store.

James enjoyed western dancing, line dancing and ballroom dancing; he also enjoyed playing cards and working in his garden. He was a member of the Elks Lodge, the Bowman Dance Club and St. Patrick's of Heatherdowns Church.

James was preceded in death by his son John, parents, sisters Helen, Dorothy, Margaret Ann, and his brother Vernon. He is survived by his loving wife of 62 years Dorothy, children Mary Lou (Galen) DeVriendt, Gary (Pam) McIntire, Twin daughters Karen and Kathleen; 10 grandchildren, 6 great grandchildren and numerous beloved nieces and nephews
