D'Arcangelo and they were married for 63 wonderful years, prior to his passing in 2021. Jane died peacefully at Hospice of Northwest Ohio on July 29, 2025.

Jane was absolutely devoted to her husband Mike, and they loved to listen and dance to Frank Sinatra. During her last days, she told her grandchildren to look into the sky and when they saw two stars close together, that was Gramma and Papa holding hands, looking down from heaven and watching over them.
