Jane Howe O'Shea, age 95 of Waterville, OH, peacefully passed away on Thursday, December 13, 2018 at Hospice of Northwest Ohio.

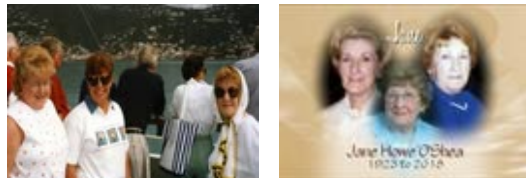
