Jeanene Ann Patton, age 76, of St. Augustine, passed away on November 28, 2013 at the Bailey Family Center for Caring Hospice, with her husband and family by her side. Born in Alexandria, Indiana, Jeanene grew up in Tecumseh, Michigan. She lived for many years in Toledo and Lima, Ohio, and for 7 years in The Villages, before moving to St. Augustine six months ago. A dedicated wife, mother, and homemaker, Jeanene also enjoyed her work as Secretary for the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Toledo, where she was employed for ten years.
