



## Jeanette Ann Schoettle

January 17, 1929 - February 12, 2014

Jeanette Ann Schoettle, age 85, passed away peacefully on February 12, 2014, at Hospice of Northwest Ohio. She was born January 17, 1929 in Toledo, Ohio to Herbert and Catherine (Turner) Fandrey. Jeanette graduated from Central Catholic High School in 1946, and began working as a secretary for the Toledo Health Department, where she worked for 21 years. She also worked as a secretary for PERS and the Catholic Cursillo for women. Jeanette lived in Osceola county Florida for 21 years with her husband William Schoettle, Sr. They loved to travel the United States together. In Florida, she was involved with the American Cancer Society. When Jeanette moved back to Toledo, she founded the Black Swamp "Red Hatters" and became the Queen Mum.

Jeanette is survived by her children Judy (James) Olsen, Bill (Karen) , and Terry Schoettle; 2 grandchildren, Matthew (Deanna) and Eric (Carla) Olsen; 5 great grandchildren, Gunner, Olivia, Lucy, Jada and Julien Olsen of Seattle, WA. Her sister Patricia Metzger also survives. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband William Sr. in 1986, her sister Kathryn Walsch, and grandson Barry Schoettle.
