Jeanne Frances Hollowed Carroll, born July 20, 1921, widow of Thomas T. Carroll, MD., died on the evening of Thursday, February 14, 2013 in the care of Hospice of NW Ohio at Sunset House surrounded by her children and grandchildren.

She was the second of four daughters born to John Francis Hollowed and Theresa Mary Magrady in Oak Park, Illinois. Following graduation from Mundelein College (now Loyola University) in Chicago, in June, 1945 she married and took up residence first in Rochester, Minnesota, where her husband had a Fellowship in General Surgery at Mayo Foundation and Mayo Clinic, then settled in her husband's hometown of Toledo to raise a family of eleven children. She lived in the Old West End and Sylvania, then at Portage Lake in Manistee, Michigan where her family had summered during her childhood.

She was devoted to family and the complexity of raising many children during times of great social, political and economic change. Through all, she was sustained by faith and love.

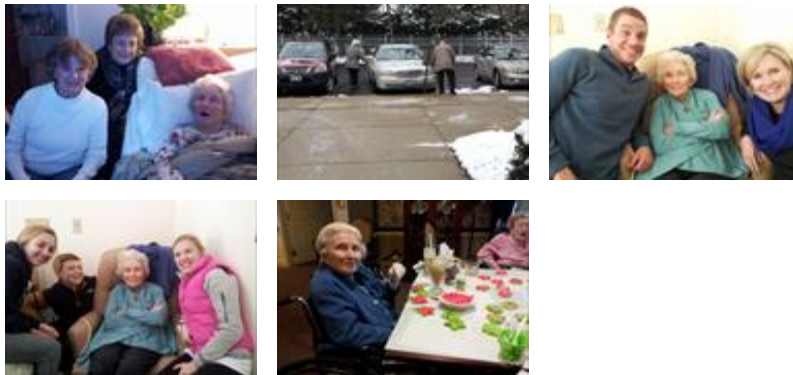
