Jeanne attended Blessed Sacrament School and graduated from Notre Dame Academy in 1950. At the University of Toledo, she was a member of Pi Beta Phi sorority. Jeanne met her husband, Jim, while on a blind date. She married her high school sweetheart on June 6, 1953. They were happily married for 55 years until Jim's passing in 2008.
