Jerome Roszczpika died on Thursday, April 5, 2012, at his daughter's home in Hilton Head, SC. Jerry was born August 19, 1916 and lived most of his life in Toledo.

He attended St. Hedwig's and Woodward High School. For many years he was employed by the Electric Autolite Company. Jerry was a veteran of World War II, landing in Normandy on D-Day+2 and remaining in the European Theater for the duration. He was discharged from the 503rd Ordnance Company earning 4 Bronze Stars.

When Autolite left Toledo, Jerry worked for the Lucas County Engineer Road Maintenance Department until his retirement.

He was married for 53 years to the late Margo Baker of Kentucky, having sons Greg and Mark and daughter Antoinette. Jerry was a member of St. Clement Parish over 50 years, being a fixture as the "best dressed" usher at the 7:30 evening Mass some 30 years. Jerry was a 3rd Degree Knight of Columbus. He was an avid volunteer with the Boy Scouts of America for 45 years holding many leadership positions and receiving numerous awards of appreciation. He saw his greatest reward as the opportunity to serve the youth and adult leaders of the local council counting many as dear and valued friends. After a stroke, Jerry spent the last 11 years living in Hilton Head, SC, enjoying the sun and observing nature.

Jerry is survived by his sister, Rita Flynn, as well as his children, daughter-in-law Wendy Bertolina and grandsons, Noah, Tobias and Jonah. He lived life as

if dining at a sumptuous banquet with friends. Being satisfied he has left the table fully expecting his friends to continue the joyous feast.
