



Jocelyn Faye Cassidy

January 3, 1936 - October 17, 2014

Jocelyn Faye Cassidy, 78 years of south Toledo, passed away on Friday October 17, 2014 while in the loving care of the staff and nurses of Lutheran Village at Wolfe Creek, where Faye had been living for the past 11 months. Faye was born in Oak Harbor Ohio on January 3, 1936. She was a graduate of Libbey High School, Class of 1953; she was also an honorary Alumni of Central Catholic High school, class of 1952. Faye married Bill Cassidy on October 10, 1959 and recently celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary. She enjoyed casino trips, playing Bunco, fishing and lunches with her Libbey Girls. She was and an avid Notre Dame Fan, a groupie of the Pride of Toledo Chorus and most of all she was a loving wife, mother, and Nana.

Faye was preceded in death by her parents; sister Dorothy Fulton; she is survived by her husband Bill Cassidy; daughter Deb Cassidy; son Bill (Kathy) Cassidy; granddaughter Tori Cassidy; special sister Donna McCoy and her uncle Jim Provonsha and aunt Mary Provonsha.
