John Patrick Cassidy Jr., age 90, died peacefully surrounded by his family on February 24, 2014 at The Manor of Perrysburg. He was born on September 27, 1923 to John P. and Margaret (McLaughlin) Cassidy in Toledo, Ohio. He attended Central Catholic High School.
