John J. Kobylarz, age 72, passed away peacefully Wednesday, May 11, 2016 at Ebeid Hospice in Sylvania, OH, surrounded by his family. John was born in Detroit on February 12, 1944 to the late John and Cecelia Kobylarz. After attending Ferris State University, John served in the National Guard for six years, and was honorably discharged as a Lieutenant Weapons Infantryman in 1971. He worked in Dearborn's Vulcan Forge plant for 30 years.

John drew lifelong comfort from his Roman Catholic faith. A member of the Knights of Columbus for 22 years, he was both a Fourth Degree Knight and a Past Faithful Navigator. 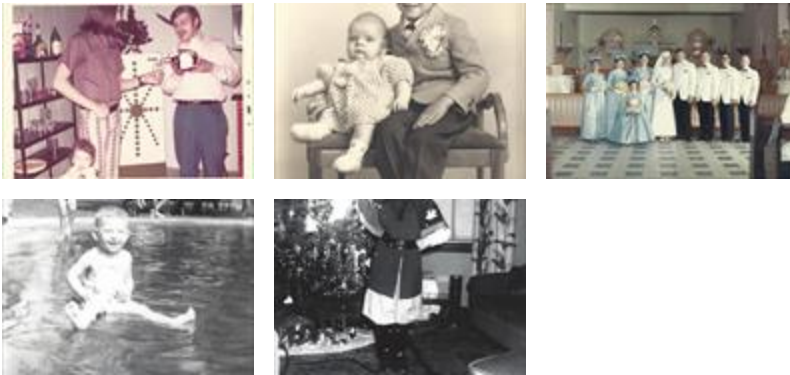
