Hones, and his loyal Dude.

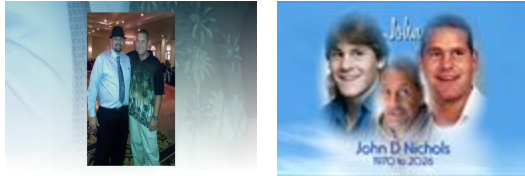

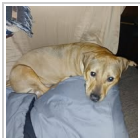
