

## Joseph Howard Dunlap

August 12, 1921 - March 28, 2010

Joseph Howard Dunlap, of Toledo Ohio, passed away peacefully on March 28, 2010 surrounded by his family. He was born in Akron, Ohio August 12, 1921 to Joseph and Virginia Dunlap. He graduated from Washington & Jefferson College in 1942 where he was in the Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity and a member of the college golf team. Joe was a Lieutenant during WWII and he piloted a B-26 in the Ninth Air Force. He returned from the war and married the love of his life, Carol Kersting, on November 23rd, 1946. He worked as a stockbroker for Merrill Lynch, and then moved to the Ohio Boxboard Company, Packaging Corporation of America and then to B&B Box as a sales representative. In 1979, along with his wife, he began a second career in real estate. He was a sales agent with Loss Reality Group. Joe had a passion for life; he loved people and had many friends. He told great jokes, was a wonderful golfer, and enjoyed music and singing. Most of all, he adored his family and all of their activities. He was a loveable character and will be missed by all.

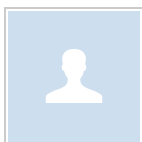
