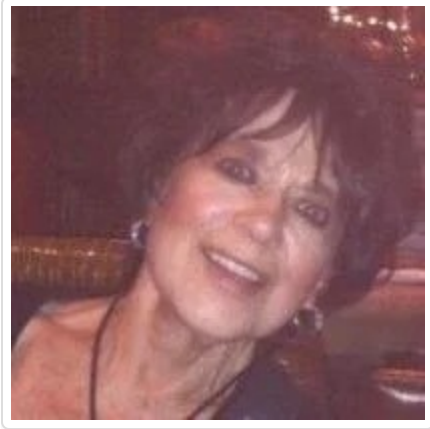




Joyce Helene Tambur
