She enjoyed the interaction with her customers and driving around delivering dozens of catalogs. She made sure everyone in the family participated in her enthusiasm with Avon.

Julie had an admiration for the outdoors and sports. She like to ski and play tennis. She was the Toledo Ski Lodge manager from 1995 to 2012. Julie enjoyed helping the members to have a memorable stay at the beautiful ski club Lodge in northern Michigan. She also spent many years on the Der Schlophen Dopen mailing committee. From day one and until the end, The Toledo Ski Club was always a big part of her Toledo life.

She spent many years a volunteer for the Kidney Foundation of Northwest Ohio. 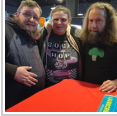
