Kathleen M. Barlage, age 97 of Maumee, OH passed away on November 30, 2021 at the Elizabeth Scott Community. She was born to Ray and Cora (Thome) Peck on October 9, 1924 in New Bavaria, OH. She graduated from Holgate High School and then proudly served her country in the U.S. Navy during WWII, stationed in Washington, D.C. Kathy a.k.a. (Dolly to her family) married Leo Barlage on February 5, 1946. She dedicated her life raising their 3 adopted children. After Leo passed in 1988, she began her second career working for McDonald's, retiring 20 years later at the age of 84. She was a 50 year member of TOPS, American Legion Post #320, an active member of St. Patrick of Heatherdowns Church and a volunteer for Heartbeat of Toledo. Kathy loved music which included playing the organ, singing in the funeral choir and playing in a local Dulcimer group performing at nursing homes and community events.

She was preceded death by her loving husband, Leo; parents; great-grandson, Logan Barlage and 9 brothers and sisters. She is survived by her children, Stephen Barlage, Kristin (Allen) Baugh and Jeffrey (Linda) Barlage; 10 grandchildren, 8 great-grandchildren, sister, Betty O'Shaughnessey and many generations of nieces and nephews.
