



## Kathryn A Blankmeyer

March 14, 1943 - January 25, 2022

Kathryn Ingram Blankmeyer, 78, of Perrysburg, OH, passed away on the morning of Tuesday, January 25, 2022 at St. Clare Commons where she had been in hospice care. Kathy was born on March 14, 1943 in Erie, PA to Arthur M. Ingram and Elizabeth (Betty) Baumann Ingram who both preceded her in death. She was a 1961 graduate of Academy High School in Erie and went on to have a long, successful career in the retail credit industry both in Erie and later in Toledo, OH where she moved with her family in 1968.

On September 7, 1974, Kathy married Tony (Norman) Blankmeyer of Columbus Grove, OH at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Toledo and they lived in their home overlooking the Maumee River in Waterville, OH for over 40 years.
