



## Loretta Ann Rizzo

January 15, 1928 - April 22, 2019

Loretta Rizzo, age 91, of Maumee, Ohio, passed away on Monday, April 22, 2019 at

the Elizabeth Scott Community.

Loretta was born on January 15, 1928 in Flint, MI. She was the daughter of Theodore

Foster and Genevieve Weber, who preceded her in death. Loretta was raised in Toledo,

Ohio by her great-uncle and aunt, Walter and Lottie Horne.

Loretta attended Whitney High School, graduating in 1945. Following high school, she

began work as a stenographer for the City of Toledo Finance Department and ended her

career as an administrative assistant for the Vice President of Purchasing at Owens

Corning Fiberglas, retiring in 1989. Loretta was a member of the Pedante Club of the

International Training in Communication organization (formally International Toastmistress Club), then founded the New Heights Club while working at OCF.

She was a member of ITC for over 20 years, holding various positions in the Great

Lakes Council, including the position of council president. Loretta was also a

member of  
the Toledo Maumee Valley Unit of the Ohio Association of Parliamentarians for  
over 10  
years.

Loretta was an active member of the Catholic church for over 60 years,  
serving the  
church community as a member of the SS Peter and Paul, St. James, and  
Our Lady of  
Perpetual Help adult choirs, as well as serving as a lector and communion  
distributor  
during her many years as a member of OLPH Catholic Church.

Loretta was also an active member of the St. Joseph's Auxiliary at the Little  
Sisters of  
the Poor in Oregon, and was a volunteer for Mobile Meals of Toledo.

Loretta married Felix John Rizzo in 1948 and celebrated 60 years of marriage  
before his  
passing in 2009. She is survived by her 10 children: Maria Rizzo (Curtis Hong)
