Mahlon C. Glenn, 89, of Maumee, Ohio, passed away peacefully on February 6th, 2026, at the Hospice of Northwest Ohio. Born in Toledo, Ohio, on February 22nd, 1936, Mahlon was one of eight children born to Doris and Wayne Glenn. He retired from Food Town in 1992 after serving as a diesel mechanic for 20 years.
