Margaret L. Braun, age 100 formerly of Toledo passed away on September 9, 2017.

She was born to immigrant parents, Albert and Elizabeth (Reichow) Zimmerman on March 13, 1917. She was the 7th of 9 children. Her father was killed at work on the railroad at age 39, leaving the oldest children to quit school and help support the family. She worked at Toledo Edison until she married her husband, Robert Braun, in 1940 and together they raised 2 children, Karen and Bob. Margaret was a Sunday school teacher at St. Petri Lutheran Church and a girl scout leader. She later worked as a Secretary at Foster Brothers and Weber Brokerage firm. She was a good golfer, a member at Valleywood Golf Course, where she played in the Woman's District Golf Association each week. She loved her golfing vacations in Hilton Head, S.C. for 20 years during the winters. In her travels, she took a cruise to Alaska and vacations to Vail, CO and Mount Rushmore.

Margaret was preceded in death by her husband of 59 years, Robert and her parents. She is survived by her daughter, Karen Braun and son, Bob Braun.
