August 31, 1916 - February 1, 2018

Marie Oberhauser, 101 years of Holland Ohio, passed away on Thursday February 1, 2018 surrounded by her loving family. Marie was born on August 31, 1916 in Mannville, Alberta, Canada to Karl and Hulda (Wagner) Bauer. Marie was the oldest girl in a family of 12 children on the farm where they all grew-up. She did much of the raising of her brothers and sisters-tending to household chores and the other children so that her mother could 'garden farm' the cucumbers that her mother grew and would sell in neighboring towns from the family's horse-drawn wagon

Marie worked in Lake Louise and Banff [in western Canada], and during World War II in an airplane plant and a pharmaceutical factory before meeting Francis, who was in the Army during WWII. Francis carried her photo with him in Burma, telling his fellow servicemen 'that's the girl I'm going to marry!' They married after the war ended, and raised five children during their 58 ½ years together. She was a devoted mother and loving wife

Marie is survived by her children, Joseph (Janice K. Means) Oberhauser, Teresa (Richard) Meek, Robert Oberhauser, Margaret (Gerald) Baumgartner, Raymond (Nancy) Oberhauser; 7 grandchildren; numerous great-grandchildren and siblings Elsie Lewis, Emma Rutledge and Arthur Bauer.
