Marilyn E. Bodenstedt, age 85, passed away May 25, 2016. Marilyn was born February 21, 1931, to Mildred and Wayne Callow. A lifelong resident of Toledo, Marilyn graduated from St. Ursula Academy and earned her teaching degree from Mary Manse College. Friends since age 13, Marilyn married her sweetheart Joe Bodenstedt on August 21, 1954. While raising her six children, Marilyn volunteered and worked part-time at St. Patrick of Heatherdowns School as a lunch mother and substitute teacher. In 1975, she returned to work full time, teaching first grade at St. Patrick's until retiring in 1996. Even in "retirement" Marilyn never stopped educating, working part-time helping children with learning and physical disabilities, substitute teaching and volunteering. As a final act of generosity, Marilyn donated her remains to The University of Toledo College of Medicine.
