I think he enjoyed that. :) He reminded me of my father whom I lost 9 years ago and towards the end I would give Martin a hug when I'd see him. Sadly, my friend Alex passed away on Oct. 12. I promised his roommate that I would visit him sometime. When I told Martin that Alex wasn't doing well, he asked me if Alex would get better. I told him that he would not be getting better. Martin then told me "Well, you can come and visit me." I assured him I would. It was at that time that I went to where I thought Martin's room was. When I didn't see Martin's name on the door plate, I asked a nurse where he was. Martin's obituary came up on the screen. :( I'm so sorry I missed his services, I would have surely gone to the funeral home. I had something for Martin today.
