Her love of church and faith were her goals to happiness in her life, sharing her time, talents, and treasures to the Sisters of Notre Dame Family Fest, preparing food for church funeral luncheons, bake sales and wherever she could fulfil the community need. In the morning and evenings, you could always find more than one rosary and Book of Prayers at her side. She also enjoyed the beauty of nature sitting in her sunroom watching the yellow finch, blue jays, cardinals, and her favorite, the humming birds.
