Mary Jane (Fox) Sulier, loving mother and lifelong resident of Toledo, Ohio was called home peacefully while surrounded by her family on Sunday Dec. 21, 2014 at the delightful age of 98. Mom was born in Toledo Ohio, the daughter of George and Elsie Fox. She graduated from Central Catholic High School in 1934. She married her sweetheart, Edgar Sulier after he returned in 1944 from duty with the Marine Corps following World War II. Mary Jane and Ed settled in Toledo, Ohio and had 3 children; Jan, Dee, and Bob. They kept their family together and today, 9 separate households consider themselves truly blessed with strong family traditions and the shared comforts of being within a short drive from each other. While their three kids were attending school, Mary Jane pursued her desire to achieve higher education by taking night classes at the University of Toledo where she graduated with honors from the College of Education. She started her new-found career by teaching developmentally challenged kids for Lucas County. She did this for two years and then added an additional thirteen years at McKinley

School where she taught both kindergarten and second grade levels. She became a superb teacher and captured the hearts and minds of her students. For many years, her classes earned the highest tested achievement levels for the City of Toledo. After retiring in 1976, she enjoyed family, grandbabies, fishing with Ed near their Catawba lake cottage, and traveling to see some "bucket list" places in the world while they still could.

Following Dad's death in 2007, after 62 years of marriage to his life-long love, Mom continued to bring a sparkle into the lives of anyone she touched. Her effervescent tender smile and contagious laughter brought her more friends than anyone could possibly imagine. While our seasonal family celebrations are now certainly tempered with wonderful memories of the past, we all watch the heavens for that fresh new star, and the Christmas Angel who we all look forward to seeing once again.
