January 17, 1924 - January 8, 2013

Mary "Libby" E. Doyle, age 88, passed away Tuesday January 8, 2013 in the Elizabeth Scott Community. She was born in 1924 in Ransy, Ohio to James and Stella Takacs. She grew up in Adena, Ohio where she went to school and met her husband Bernard, whom she married after WWII. They moved to Lima, Ohio in the early 1950's and both worked at Randall Bearings. After the birth of their children, she became a full time homemaker and mother. In the early 1970's, she went back to work at Montgomery Wards where she worked until her retirement. At one time, Libby was very active at St. John's and St. Charles Churches in Lima. With her health failing, she moved to Toledo about a year ago to be close to family.
