Maureen Ann (Mackley) Hoover, 71, died Monday, August 4, 2014 at Hospice of Northwest Ohio in Perrysburg. She was born on October 5, 1942. She resided in the Old West End and South Toledo throughout her life.

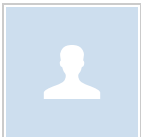
