Max Veitch, age 84 of Toledo, passed away on December 4, 2008. He was born to Paul and Gertrude Veitch on September 23, 1924. He was a 1942 graduate of Libbey High School and then enlisted in the United States Army Air Force. Max proudly served his country during WWII as a Radio Operator-Gunner. He was shot down on his 18th mission and was a P.O.W. in Germany and was also awarded the Purple Heart and an Air Medal.

Upon returning from the war, he attended and graduated from the University of Toledo. He spent his career working for Toledo Edison, as an Accountant, retiring after 37 years of service. Max was an avid bowler and golfer. He was a member of Maumee Valley Chapter of Ex-P.O.W. of America, American Legion, V.F.W. and the 44th Bomb Group Veteran's Association.
