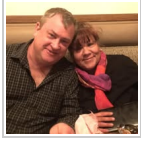

# Tribute Wall

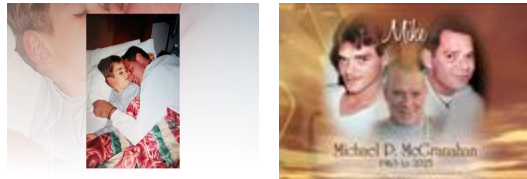
