Myrna Gaye Bosch, of Toledo Ohio, passed away on Wednesday, August 31, 2022 at her home in the company of her two sons. She was 85.

Myrna was born on September 16, 1936 in Toledo, Ohio, daughter of Walter and Esther Ducket. She attended DeVilbiss High School, graduating in 1954. Myrna had a successful career in real estate spanning three decades with the Melle and Danberry companies. Myrna and her loving husband of 59 years, Daniel Francis Bosch, had two sons, Greg and Dan.

advocate. It was her unwavering support combined with tireless love which gave us the encouragement and confidence to dream big and stretch to new heights.

Her love extended to embrace her daughters-in-law, Kathy and Mehrnaz, becoming in many regards their second mom. Mom taught us how to enjoy the simple pleasures of enjoying family and friends and showed us that laughter is great medicine. For her grandchildren, Nana walked on water with endless hugs, love and laughs as well as her repertoire of funny sayings. Mom, these words do not begin to express how much we love you and how thankful we are for the life you lived, full of love and laughter. We will miss you beyond belief.
