



Nicholas M Krochmalny

October 4, 1940 - February 26, 2022

Nicholas M. Krochmalny, 81, passed away peacefully on February 26, 2022. He was born on October 4, 1940 in Toledo to Nicholas and Cecelia (Wilhelm) Krochmalny. He graduated from Macomber High School, class of 1958, majoring in woodworking. Nick learned a lot of practical skills there, one of which was building a telescope from his interest in Astronomy. He was a proud member of their golf team. Nick earned an Associates degree in Engineering from the University of Toledo.

He started his career as a young boy, delivering papers for the Toledo Blade, with his Black Schwinn Phantom bicycle. After college, he started with American Motors Jeep, then DeVilbiss, and finished his career with Ford Motor Company in Dearborn, MI.

Nick started a Sunday morning men's senior hockey league at Tam- O - Shanter. His first love was woodworking, and second was golf. He was a caddy at Inverness and for the US Open in 1958 and belonged to the Inverness Caddy Association. He was instrumental in organizing a 60 year reunion of those caddies. Nick was an avid wedding and portrait photographer. He was an active member of St. Jude's Catholic Church, and later St. Patrick of Heatherdowns. Nick was proud of his Ukrainian heritage.

Nick is survived by his loving wife Bonnie, his son Matthew John Krochmalny, and his daughter Amy (Michael) Stebli; grandchildren Margaret, Nicholas and Alyssa Stebli; brothers Bernard (Annette) Krochmalny of Cincinnati, OH and John (Barbara) Krochmalny of Sylvania. Many nieces and nephews also survive.
