Patricia S. Randolph, age 84, of Toledo Ohio passed away on Saturday August 21, 2010 in the Sunset House, surrounded by her loving family.

Patricia was born in Detroit Michigan on May 18, 1926 to Leonard L. and Helen (Douglas) Healy. She attended the Academy of the Sacred Heart in Bloomfield Hills, MI and graduated from Manhattanville College in New York. Pat's love for family and friends and her Irish heritage were always apparent, particularly on St. Patrick's Day. Her wit and quick responses often provided much laughter and entertaining moments. She enjoyed attending her grandchildren's events and was extremely proud of all their accomplishments.
