June 14, 1924 - October 26, 2014

Patricia R. Syring, age 90, a longtime Toledoan and a Gesu parishoner, died October 26, 2014, at Sunset House, where she had resided for 10 months. She was born Patricia Rosemary Madden on June 14, 1924, in Detroit, to Patrick Henry and Mary Agnes Madden. She graduated from Immaculata High School and, in 1946, from Marygrove College in Detroit. She worked in personnel for General Motors and at Marygrove College prior to her marriage to William J. Syring on October 6, 1956, and her move to Toledo.

For many years, she enjoyed her volunteer service as a Juvenile Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) and her volunteer work at various organizations, notably Heartbeat of Toledo.

A caring and loving wife, mother, grandmother, aunt and friend, she is predeceased by her husband, and her brothers, Rev. John F. and Rev. Robert J. Madden, priests of the Congregation of St. Basil. She is survived by daughters Julia, Mary Drumm (Mitchell), sons Wm. Patrick, Joseph, John, and Paul (Laurie), and grandchildren Sarah and Joseph Syring; Elizabeth, Emily, and Katherine Drumm; and Paul Madden and Brigid Syring.

A funeral mass will be celebrated Wednesday, October 29 at 11:00 a.m. at Gesu Roman Catholic Parish, where the family will greet guests beginning at 9:00 a.m. Interment will follow at Calvary Cemetery.
