Paul Gerard Gorman, Jr., 78 of Holland, Ohio passed away peacefully on Friday, September 16, 2022 at ProMedica Toledo Hospital. Paul was born February 14, 1944 in Toledo, Ohio to Paul Gerard Gorman, Sr. and Florence Lopinski Gorman. Paul was a 1962 graduate of St. Francis de Sales High School where he met a great group of friends and they have remained close for over 55 years. After high school, Paul graduated from Adrian College in Adrian, MI in 1967 where he was president of his class. In 1971, Paul received his Juris Doctor degree in Law from the University of Toledo. He was a lawyer for the Department of Justice in Washington, DC, a case law editor for Lexis Nexis and a wedding photographer which he thoroughly enjoyed doing.

Paul was married on August 13, 1971 in Toledo, OH to his lovely wife, Linda (Petrisko) Gorman. Paul's hobbies included photography, reading, spending time with his grandson Jackson and his granddaughters, Ava, Molly and Moira, as well as being any place by the water.

His humor was quick-witted and he always had a good "dad joke" at the ready.
