Born to Paul and Dorothy Holan, Nov. 10, 1951 in Charleroi, PA, Paul passed away Saturday morning, Jan. 30, 2010 in his Perrysburg home after a 9 month battle with cancer.

Paul received his undergraduate degree from California State College in Pennsylvania and his Masters of Education degree from Youngstown State.

Paul proudly served his country 7 years as a member of the Pennsylvania National Guard.

He began his 33 years in public school education at Burton Berkshire school district then moved to Willard, OH where he was an Earth Science teacher. He loved coaching football and track and eventually became the athletic director. He moved to the Anthony Wayne schools in 1999 and became an assistant principal and the athletic director retiring in 2008.

He was a past president of the Northwest Ohio Athletic Association and was awarded "Northwest Ohio Athletic Director of the Year".

A handyman to the extreme, Paul was willing and ready to help any family,

friend or neighbor tackle any problem they gave him. In the past few years, he and Nancy began touring vineyards and creating and bottling his own wine.

An avid Pittsburgh Steelers and Ohio State football fan, he was happiest when spending time with his family and many friends.

He was preceded in death by his father, Paul. He is survived by his loving wife, Nancy, children Abby Holan, Cuyahoga Falls, OH, Ashlee Holan, Toledo and Seth Holan of Port Huron, MI, his mom, Dorothy Holan and grandchildren, Bella and Peyton Holan and Priya and Ian Roy. His step daughter, Jennifer (Partha) Roy also survives along with special aunt Nancy (Ralph) Cartino and other aunts, uncles and cousins.

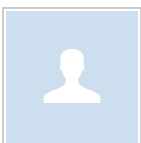
