Paul E. Richard, age 86 of Toledo, passed away on November 26, 2011 at Hospice of Northwest Ohio, Toledo.

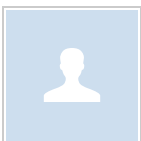

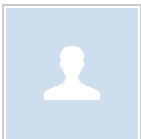
