Phillip Eugene Hill, Jr., 62, of Toledo, OH passed away from complications related to Covid-19 on March 1, 2021 at the Promedica Toledo Hospital, surrounded by his family.

Phillip Eugene Hill Jr. was born December 26th 1958 to Phillip E. Hill Sr. and Josephine A. Stribling. Phillip attended Scott High School, where he graduated in 1977.

Phillip was extremely hard working. He was employed by Toledo Stamping and Classic Auto early on in his working career. He worked for the State of Ohio, Department of Youth Services as a Juvenile Corrections Officer for over 33 years where he remained employed until his passing. He worked at the Maumee, Marion, Mohican and Indian River facilities during his time with the State. While working at Maumee Youth Camp, in collaboration with the Lucas County Prosecutor's Office Victims Forum Program; he helped educate the community about the impact of violence. He worked as private security at different events in the Toledo area. He even worked as a driver/security the first time the entertainer Prince performed in Toledo. In his spare time, he acted in commercials for various companies including Banner Mattress, White Knight Limousine and Car Stereo One.

Phillip was Superman to many and would show up for anybody who needed him. He was handy and would fix most things before calling in a professional.

He had many talents, including the ability to sew and he was known to make some of his own clothing.

Phillip was preceded in death by his father Phillip Eugene Hill, Sr. and his baby brother Dana Davis. Phillip is survived by and will be dearly missed by his mother Josephine Davis, his children Phillip (Katherine) Hill, Shontae Hill and Naquita (Trey) Hill; Grandchildren Leisay, Xavier, Kylie, Marley, Dior, DaJuan, Charli, Jordan, Dashaun and Justice; siblings Steve (Lori) Jackson, Corey Hill, Chana (Reuben) Brown, Phyllis Hill, Denita (Tim) Davis, Deanna Davis, Deni (Jason) Davis, Dennis Davis, Dion (Tamar) Davis, Galen Hill, Carmen Hill, Aaron (Megan) Hill and Veronica (Thaine) Ganshorn, and a host of nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins, friends and extended work family.
