



Raymond Charles Overy

Raymond C. Overy, age 76 of Perrysburg, passed away on June 2nd, 2017 at St. Luke's Hospital. He was born on October 8, 1940 in Toledo, Ohio to Earl Overy and Cecilia (Brainard) Overy. He attended Immaculate Conception Grade School and graduated from Central Catholic High School in 1958. He served his country joining the US Air Force and married Dorothy M. 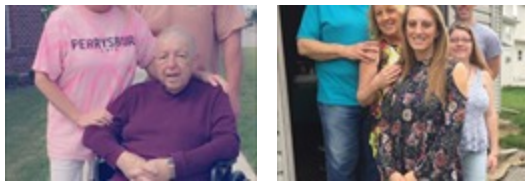
