

## Robert Joseph Brennan

December 5, 1916 - November 17, 2011

Robert Joseph Brennan, age 94 of south Toledo, passed away on Thursday Nov. 17, 2011, surrounded by his loving family, in the Elizabeth Scott Community.

Bob was born in Port Huron Michigan on December 5, 1916 to Joseph and Eleanor (Fisher) Brennan. The family moved to Cleveland Ohio in 1928 where he attended Cathedral Latin High School. The family then moved to Rossford Ohio in 1934 where he finished high school and attended the University of Toledo. Bob served in the United States Army Air Corp during WWII and was honorably discharged in 1943. He worked in sales for the former Koerber & Buckeye Brewery Company and later became Director of Sales for the former Commodore Perry Hotel until his retirement.

Bob was a charter member of St. Patrick of Heatherdowns Church and was a past president of their Holy Name Society; he was also an usher and coached the school's baseball teams for seven years. Bob was a past member of the Maumee Elks, the Old Newsboys, the Kiwanis of Downtown Toledo and the American Legion. Bob was a devoted Notre Dame football and Cleveland Indians fan.

Bob was preceded in death by his parents and son-in-law Brent Kahler; he is survived by his loving wife of 65 years, Jean, children, James E. (Amy)

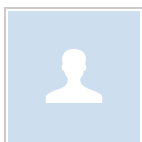

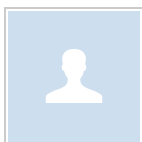
