Robert Francis Juhasz, age 61 of South Toledo lost his battle with cancer and passed away peacefully at Hospice of Northwest Ohio, Toledo on July 16, 2016 with his family by his side.

He grew up in the Birmingham neighborhood of East Toledo and was proud of his Hungarian heritage. He attended St. Stephen's Catholic grade school and was a 1973 graduate of Cardinal Stritch High School.

Rob was inducted into the Cardinal Stritch High School Hall of Fame in December 2015 as a member of their 1972 championship football team. He also played varsity baseball, track and field. In 1998, he was inducted into the Birmingham Hall of Fame for football.

He worked for the City of Toledo for 35 years, retiring in 2011 from Engineering Services. He was an usher at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church and volunteered every year for the church festivals and picnics. Rob was a member of the VFW Post# 4906, the Maumee Eagles and the Moose in Bradenton, FL. Rob and Maureen spent the past five winter seasons at their condo in Bradenton, FL. where they made many close friends.

Rob was preceded in death by his parents John and Margaret (Borie) Juhasz. He is survived by his wife, Maureen; daughter, Kerry (Brent Tary) Juhasz; brothers Jack and Joseph Juhasz; nephews, Jade, Beau, Justin; nieces,

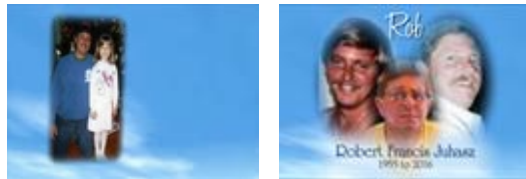
