Robert Clarence Kuhl, age 92 of Toledo, passed away on Tuesday, April 6, 2010.

Robert had a wonderful life as a member of The Greatest Generation. He was born on March 19, 1918 to Clarence and Rose Kuhl. Bob graduated from Scott High School in 1937 and spent two years in the Civilian Conservation Corps in Nevada. Bob joined the Navy on the day after Christmas, 1941, and served on the USS Franks in the Pacific through the end of the war. Bob started his career as an engineering draftsman at Willys-Overland and retired from Chrysler Jeep after 38 years. Bob enjoyed participating in the Boy Scouts with his four sons, fishing with his lifelong friend Eddie Stoiber, researching genealogy, collecting coins, and spending summers with his wife at their cabin in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.

Bob married Evelyn in 1946 and was by her side for 62 years until she passed away in 2008. Bob is survived by his children, Margaret (William) Shrier, John (Debby), Bob (Joyce), Neil (Robin), and Ronald (Celia); 13 grandchildren; 8 great-grandchildren; and his brother, Terry Kuhl.
