Robert "Bob" Przybylski, age 85 of Toledo, passed away February 10, 2023. He was born to Sigmund and Harriet (Skolmoski) Przybylski on May 3, 1937 in Toledo, OH. He was a graduate of St. Theresa's Grade School and Macomber Vocational School. Bob enlisted in the National Guard and served proudly in the U.S. Army. He married the love of his life, Patricia Ann Kowalski, on October 10, 1959, and they raised three children. Bob spent his career working as a Skilled Tool Maker for the Spicer Division of Dana Corporation for 29 years and for the Chrysler Machining Plant in Perrysburg for 11 years. He was a member of the Polish Genealogy Society, the Bowsher High School Athletic Boosters, and the University of Toledo Rocket Club. He enjoyed fishing, dartball and bowling. Bob was loved as a coach of CYO sports teams. An avid traveler, he visited over 60 countries, including three memorable trips to Poland. Watching Polar Bears on the Canadian tundra; Brown Bears in Brooks Falls, Alaska; and African wildlife on a Kenyan safari were Bob's favorite adventure trips.

Bob was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Patricia Ann Fetzer. He is survived by his loving wife, Pat; sons, Steven and Kenneth; daughter, Deanne (Ed) Krisjanis; and many nieces, nephews and cousins.
