After graduating from Scott High School in Toledo, OH, RoseMary entered the U.S. Air Force, proudly serving at Norton Air Force Base, CA; and it is there that she met a fellow Airman and the love of her life, Constantine C. "Gus" Galoosis. They married in 1955, and RoseMary left the Air Force to travel the world with Gus.
