Roy Gordon Fink, age 84 of Toledo, OH passed away peacefully on Thursday, April 25, 2013, in his home at the Swan Creek Retirement Village in Toledo. He was born to Roy and Gertrude Fink on May 20, 1928 in West Farmington, OH. He joined the U.S. Marines at age 16 and served his country proudly from 1944-1947. Roy founded Gordon Plastics which was acquired by Plastigage of Jackson, MI from where he retired as President and CEO. He was also instrumental in the early growth of Dinesol in Niles, OH as well as founding Gordon Poly-Technics. He was an Emeritus member of the Board of Governors for the Shriner's Hospital for crippled children, the Shrine's Royal order of Jesters and a 33 1/3 degree member Mason.

Roy was quick with a smile, a hearty laugh and greatly enjoyed his family, friends and associates.

He was preceded in death by his loving wife Marie, his parents, sister, Lois (Dale) and great-granddaughter, Julia Woodyard. Left to cherish his memory are daughters, Terry (John) Woodyard, Colleen Jackson; son, Kevin (Annette) Fink; as well as 8 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren.

Per Roy's wishes there will be no formal visitation or funeral services. A private service will take place during his interment at South Jackson Community Church Cemetery.
