



## Roy Milton Norman

November 30, 1919 - January 4, 2010

Roy Milton Norman, born November 30, 1919, in Anacortes, Washington passed away January 4, 2010. He lived in South Toledo for the last sixty years.

He had served in the Army from April 22, 1942 to January 7, 1946 in the campaigns of Ardennes, Rhineland and Central Europe, earning the decorations of American Theatre service medal, European African Middle Eastern service medal, Good conduct, Purple Heart and Victory medals. He met the love of his life, Roberta, while in the service and moved to Toledo to marry her in 1946. They had almost 60 years together before she preceded him in death in 2003.

Roy loved fishing, reading adventure novels and sports, especially Mud Hens baseball games downtown. He made friends everywhere he went and never met a stranger.

Roy is survived by his sister, Ethel Barcott and family; son, Michael and daughter-in-law, Anne; granddaughter, Elizabeth (J.B.) Graham and grandson, Christopher Norman. He also had many treasured nieces and nephews in Ohio, Michigan, Missouri, Texas, Florida, New York and Washington, whom he kept in touch with over the years.
