



## Russell L Field

November 23, 1925 - July 11, 2009

Russell Field, age 83 of south Toledo, died Saturday July 11, 2009 in the Hospice of Northwest Ohio Toledo inpatient center.

Russ was born in Toledo Ohio to Russell and Martha Field on Nov. 23, 1925. He attended Libby High School and served in the United States Army Air Corps as a Corporal during WWII where he received the American Theater Ribbon, Asiatic-Pacific Ribbon and the Victory Medal. Russell returned to Toledo and served as a Toledo Police Officer for 30 years retiring as a homicide detective in 1978. He also worked for the former Mary Warning Flower Shop for 35 years and was a Chauffeur for the Dana Corp for 5 years. Russell also drove for Kahn and Diehl Optometrists.

Russ was a lifetime member of the American Legion Post 642; past commander of Toledo Police Post 512 and was a member of the Rossford Eagles #2322

Russ was preceded in death by his wife Shirley Field in 1996. He is survived by his children Sharon (Mark) Weirich, Kenneth (Diana) Field, Richard Field, David (Jennette) Field, Ronald (Sharon) Field, Joe Etts, Tonjia Hartle, Brian (Shelly) Field Keith Field; loving friend Anna Eichelberger, 15 grandchildren, 7 great grandchildren; sister Sister Eileen Otting SGN; brother Robert Otting and loving pet Abby.
