Stanley Przybylek, 90, of Maumee, Ohio went home to our Lord on Wednesday, July 9 in his home. He was born on Easter morning April 21, 1935 to Stanley and Kathryn (Sadowski) Przybylek.

Stan attended Central Catholic High School graduating in 1953. He continued his education at Capital University enjoying courses of theology.
