Suzanne (Keenan) Wyatt, of Toledo, passed away peacefully on July 18, 2013.

Suzanne was born on September 18, 1929 to John and Joanna (Zytkus) Kocinski.

She was a graduate of Woodward High School, where she received military commendations for speeches she held to raise money for the war effort during WWII. Suzanne attended The University of Toledo before working as an executive assistant at the parent Pepsi Cola Company, in Los Angeles, CA. Suzanne served for several years on the Sylvania Township Zoning Board in the 1970's. She also served as a manager of the former Greenwood Mall, in Toledo.

She is survived by her daughter, Melissa Burden and son Richard (Skip) Keenan; and grandsons Charles and Robert Burden and John Keenan.

Suzanne was preceded in death by her parents, and by her loving husband, Colonel Charles E. Wyatt, whom she married on October 15, 1977, at Wright Patterson AFB.

There was no visitation. Private services were held at Calvary Cemetery where Suzanne was laid to rest with her husband "Charlie" and her loving parents. Memorial contributions can be made to the Toledo Humane Society.
